## School Play

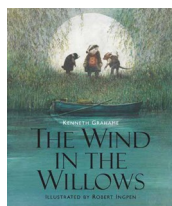
Tickets for the school play will be available soon. A text will be sent out. We will limit them initially to 2 per family.
