Illness

If your child is exhibiting any signs of Covid, high temperature, continuous cough or loss of taste or smell, the DfE recommends that you book a PCR test for your child and do not use the rapid LFD test kits available for the adults in the household. If a positive result is returned the whole household will have to isolate for 10 days from the when the positive test result was obtained. However, if a negative PCR result is obtained then your child can return to school immediately and the household can return to normal.

If your child has sickness or diarrhoea please keep your child at home for 48 hours after the last episode. All illness should be reported to the school office via phone or email.

If your child needs to be taken out of school for a medical appointment please can you send a copy of the letter to the office or send an email with the details on if the appointment was made by telephone.


